There is no change in Long Han Wen's therapy, which mainly focuses on his endurance and ability to control his head. Lying in a prone position, Long Han Wen practices raising his head up and supporting himself with his hands. He is determined to become more independent. He also stands in a standing frame to strengthen his leg muscles. He has shown unstable emotions recently and often cries and shouts. He is sometimes a bit lazy when doing therapy exercises, but if he is told that he may get a reward when he finishes, he will be very happy.

Long Han Wen wants to improve the fine motor control of his right hand. Every day before class, the teacher asks the pupils to clap their hands and Long Han Wen is very careful to follow the instructions. In communication class, he likes playing games and making movements to communicate with the teachers. Every time the teacher asks a question, Long Han Wen raises his hand as he loves to offer his opinion.

He really enjoys cooking class because he gets to eat lots of delicious food, and he loves to have pancakes cooked by the caregiver. He also likes music class and listening to rhythmic music. When he gets to play the drums, he laughs happily and has a real sense of achievement. Long Han Wen has been learning to use a computer for some time and he has a great time playing games with the teacher's guidance. It is very difficult for Long Han Wen to finish some simple tasks, such as clicking and touching the screen. Sometimes he gets very anxious, but he is very cooperative and manages to finish his task with the patient guidance of the teacher. The computer class opened a new session for him, which offers him a chance to learn more new things.

As for his diet, Long Han Wen is not a picky eater. He is able to have a large bowl of rice, meat and vegetables at every meal. He also likes snacks. When the caregiver gives him snacks, Long Han Wen can't wait to put them into his mouth. He always plays with some toys on his bed by himself during the lunchtime nap period. He does not sleep very well, and if a sound wakes him up he sometimes screams and shouts.
